DONGJIANG GUANGYA SCHOOL

Dongjiang Guangya School is an academy-style boarding school founded by Guangdong Guangya Middle School (Zhang Zhidong Academy), a century-old prestigious school, in Huizhou, Guangdong only 20 kilometers away from Huawei's headquarters. It has gradually become an integrated education organization for elementary, junior, and high schools. The school campus is over 300 acres and has a total investment of over US\$100 million. Its advanced teaching facilities and educational equipment are at the forefront of modern education.

Educational Field Trips


Each semester 1-2 educational field trips are organized for students.
